Health Insurance Coverage of Breastfeeding Support and Supplies

Capp Bill to Improve Health Coverage for Military Moms Now Law

The TRICARE Moms Improvement Act, introduced by Representative Lois Capps (CA-24) was signed into law by President Obama as an amendment to the National Defense Authorization Act (H. R. 4435). The new law makes breastfeeding supplies, services, and counseling available to military family members who have federal TRICARE health insurance. Such services are already a required benefit in private health insurance plans following passage of the Affordable Care Act. Representative Capps spreadheaded the effort to get the provision passed. Capps stated the new law will give "...military families access to the same services that are available to those who have private insurance..." Additionally, she reiterated the importance of "...ensuring our military moms have the resources they need to feed and care for their newborns if they chose to breastfeeding."
