
# **Probation Department Statistics**


#### As of Dec 31 2013, there are 334 AB 109 Probationers on active supervision.







The percentage of split sentences has continued to increase, from 9% (Oct 2011-Sep 2012) to 18% (Oct 2012-Sep 2013). However, Solano County is still well under the statewide average (28%) and dramatically less than neighboring Contra Costa County (89%).




1170 Non-Split 1170 Split





### The PRCS assessed by the LS/CMI (to recidivate) has shown relatively minor variation when viewed from Jan-Dec 2013.






City of Residence for Supervised AB109

The highest concentrations of AB109 (N=344) per population are Vallejo & Fairfieldof the 275 PRCS, 40 (15%) consider themselves transient or homeless;

16 in Vallejo, 16 in Fairfield, 3 in Suisun City, 3 in Vacaville, 1 in Benicia, and 1 unincorporated





Gender differences between PRCS (N=275), 1170 (N=59), and Solano Census (N=413,344)






#### 1170's are younger, on average




The age difference between 1170 and PRCS remains, with large variances in the 26-30 and 41-50 age groups








#### The PRCS Ethnic profile has remained consistent, keeping in line with historical data



October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 – January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2013






