INFORMATION RELEASE 02/03/15 PARLOEE AT LARGE ARRESTED WITH LOADED FIREARM

Just before 2 a.m. this morning, Solano County Sheriff's Deputy Coy Caulfield initiated a traffic stop for a traffic violation in the area of Rollingwood Drive and Lockwood Drive in the City of Vallejo. Caulfield contacted a female driver and then spoke with the male passenger, later identified as 36 year old Damian Phillips of American Canyon.

After a brief investigation, Caulfield learned that Phillips had provided a false name when initially contacted and had an outstanding warrant out of the California Department of Corrections for being a parolee at large. While taking Phillips into custody, deputies discovered a loaded 40 caliber Glock semi-automatic handgun in Phillips' pants pocket. The Glock handgun found on Phillips was not reported stolen; however, the investigation into how Phillips obtained the gun is still on going.

Phillips was arrested and booked into the Solano County Jail on the following list of felony charges: carrying a concealed firearm in a vehicle, carrying a loaded firearm in public, possession of a firearm by a convicted felon or drug user, possession of a firearm by a person previously convicted of possessing a firearm and the California Department of Corrections warrant for being a parole at large.

Phillips is currently being held at the Solano County Jail with a no bail status due to a parole hold. Phillips' first scheduled court appearance is set for Thursday, February 5th, at 1:30 p.m. in the Fairfield Courthouse.
