A. Approve a one-time allocation of \$108,263 to First 5 California for the Managed Risk Medical Insurance Board to expand Healthy Families health insurance coverage for children 0-5 beyond the enrollment cap established for the program in December 2008.

Purpose: to provide insurance coverage and prevent children 0-5 from being placed on a Healthy Families waiting list for the period of December 19, 2008 to June 30, 2009. **Source of funds:** unanticipated funds for FY2008/09 resulting from the update to the Long Term Financial Plan and Program Investment Plans approved by the First 5 Solano Commission in December 2008.
