INFORMATION RELEASE 09/04/15 **Three Arrests Made During Sex Registrant Compliance Check**

On Thursday, September 3rd, 2015, the Solano County Sheriff's Office Investigations Bureau, Solano County Probation Department, and the State of California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation/Parole joined efforts to conduct compliance checks on sex registrants located within Solano County. The compliance checks were funded by the Sexual Assault Felony Enforcement (S.A.F.E.) Task Force grant overseen by the Santa Clara County Sheriff's Office. Compliance checks on registered sex offenders who reside within Solano County are conducted regularly to insure the subjects are adhering to the terms of their registration and conditions of their probation and/or parole.

The team performed seven checks, resulting in the arrest of three people; one was arrested for failing to comply with the terms of his parole, one was arrested for an outstanding warrant, and one was arrested for possession of a controlled substance.

The Solano County Sheriff's Office has been a member of the Region II S.A.F.E. Task Force since 2008. The mission of the S.A.F.E. Task Force is to reduce the number of non-compliant sex registrants within the region. The 12 counties involved in the task force work together to achieve this goal of protecting the citizens of Solano County.
