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## 8.7 Qualified Application Certificate (QAC)

This subsection will apply to the Senior Public Works Maintenance Workers assigned to the Channel Maintenance crew. employees in the classification series of Senior Public Works Maintenance Workers, Public Works Maintenance Workers, Airport Maintenance Worker, Groundskeeper, and Park Ranger that are approved by their supervisor and/or manager for the Qualified Applicator Certificate (QAC).

## A. The County will pay:

- 1. The initial application and renewal fees required for a Qualified Applicator Certificate (QAC).
- 2. Examination fees associated with initial and one reexamination fee for Laws and Regulations, Right-of-Way pest category, and Aquatic pest category upon proof of passing the examination.
- 3. Fees associated with the accumulation of no less than <u>twenty (20)</u> hours of approved Continuing Education (CE) every two <u>(2)</u> years before certificate renewal, four <u>(4)</u> hours must cover the topic of Pesticide Laws and Regulations. <u>Evidence of successful completion of the course must be submitted.</u>
- 4. Fees associated with membership in the Pesticide Applicators Professional Association (PAPA)

## B. The County will Pay:

Fees associated with Continuing education as offered to Senior Public Works
Maintenance Workers, upon approval of the channel maintenance supervisor
and/or the Operations Manager. Employees taking courses which encroach on
their regular scheduled working hours shall be entitled to continuing education
time.

## 8.8 Qualified Applicators Certificate (QAC) Incentive Pay

Employees in the elasses <u>classification series</u> of Groundskeeper, Park Ranger, <u>Park Ranger Assistant</u>, Public Works Maintenance Worker, and <u>Airport Maintenance Worker</u> <u>Public Works Maintenance Worker (Senior)</u> who possess a State of California Qualified Applicators Certificate who are regularly assigned duties consistent with the use of such certification will receive a 1.5% pay differential for possession of such certificate.

For incentive pay to continue, the employee must continuously maintain a valid certification and be assigned duties consistent with the use of such certification.
