ROUTINE ASP CHECK DISCOVERS MARIJUANA GROW Solano County Sheriff's Office

February 26, 2009

A Fairfield man was taken back into custody after having violated his Alternative Sentencing Program (ASP) terms. On Tuesday, February 24th personnel with the Sheriff's ASP, assisted by the Sheriff's Community Oriented Policing and Problem Solving Unit (COPPS), conducted a random compliance check on the 2100 block of Fairfield Avenue in the City of Fairfield.

During the compliance check sheriff's personnel discovered an indoor marijuana grow located within an outbuilding located on the property. The grow site was elaborately equipped with watering, lighting, and temperature controls. Sixty-one live plants were discovered with an additional two pounds of freshly cut and harvested marijuana. The estimated street value of all the marijuana discovered is approximately \$162,500. The Sheriff's Cal-MMET/Sol-NET unit (California Multi Jurisdictional Methamphetamine Enforcement Team/Solano Narcotics Enforcement Team) responded to assist with the investigation.

44-year-old Kircle Ray Joubert was arrested and taken back into custody on his original charge of Burglary. New drug charges are pending.
