**DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SUSPECT TAKEN INTO CUSTODY**

Just after 7 a.m. this morning the Solano County Sheriff's Office dispatch center received a call from a family member of a domestic violence victim. The family member informed dispatch that the victim was currently at their residence and needed to talk to deputies about an incident that had occurred earlier in the morning, at approximately 4 a.m. At the time of the call the victim informed dispatch that she did not need medical attention and that she was pregnant.

Deputies responded to the location of the victim and gathered information with regards to what had taken place earlier at the victim's residence, where she lived with the suspect, in the 4400 block of Brown School Lane. Brown School Lane is in the unincorporated area of Solano County just outside the city of Vacaville.

Responding deputies determined that the victim did not need medical attention and that a domestic violence incident had occurred in the early morning hours. Deputies also obtained information from the victim that the suspect was armed with a firearm and was possibly under the influence of narcotics.

Deputies then responded to the residence, established a perimeter and attempted to contact the suspect. The suspect did not immediately respond to the deputies' request to come out of the residence and was eventually taken into custody inside the residence without incident. Deputies also located a stolen firearm that the suspect had possessed earlier when the original crime occurred.

The suspect, Noah Guirguis, (a 23 years old Vacaville resident) was later booked into the Solano County Jail on the following list of felony charges: Attempted Murder, Kidnapping, False Imprisonment, Assault with a Deadly Weapon, Domestic Violence, Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon and Receiving Stolen Property (the firearm). The firearm recovered from Guirguis' residence was reported stolen from within Solano County.

Guirguis is currently being held in the Solano County Jail with a no bail status, due to the attempted murder charge, and his first court appearance is set for Tuesday December 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2014 at 1:30 p.m. in the Fairfield Courthouse. See attached photo of Noah Guirguis.
