## RE: Request to Co-Sponsor the Housing for All Act (H.R. 6989)

Dear Representative Thompson:

On behalf of the Solano County Board of Supervisors, I write to request that you co-sponsor the Housing for All Act (H.R. 6989). Introduced by Representative Ted Lieu, the bill will bolster ongoing state and local efforts to create more stable and affordable housing for Californians, including those who are experiencing, or at risk of experiencing, homelessness.

The measure is an important contribution to addressing the affordable housing crisis, as it would direct significant federal investments in programs that have been shown to alleviate housing shortages and reduce homelessness. Along with the historic investments in Governor Newsom's California Comeback Plan, the Housing for All Act will help support an array of innovative solutions that will change the lives of many Californians.

Similar to all California counties, Solano has an affordable housing crisis. The Solano County 2021 Affordable Housing Needs Report revealed that 80 percent of our extremely low-income residents pay more than 50 percent of their income toward housing and 10,159 low-income renter households do not have access to an affordable home. Renters in the County need to earn \$31.43 per hour - 2.2 times the state minimum wage - to afford the average monthly asking rent of \$1,634.
