Benicia pipeline updates - local emergency proclamation and temporary bypass



A local emergency has been proclaimed in Benicia due to the collapse of a main water transmission line in Fairfield. This emergency declaration will allow all available resources to go into repairing the main line. In the meantime, a bypass line from Cordelia to Benicia should start

testing today, April 7, in order to restore some water to Benicia. The mandatory water conservation is still in effect. For more information, read the press release here.
