2024 Non-Disposal Facility Element (NDFE) Draft

Release of the 2024 NDFE draft will be presented for final comments including an update on the on-going development of the web-based commodities tracker.

(Effective January 1, 2012, there are no longer specific regulatory requirements for public noticing or approval to update an NDFE pursuant to AB 341, Chapter 4.5, Statutes of 2011. Jurisdictions should provide to the County any changes to facilities processing its recyclables and/or organics, or when siting a new nondisposal facility within its boundaries, that were not previously identified in the current NDFE. It is the County's responsibility to submit NDFE updates to CalRecycle to append the updated information currently on their file.)

5. SB 1383 CAPACITY PLANNING
