PUBLIC HEARINGS

1. PUBLIC HEARING to consider Sign Application No.: SGN-24-02 of Michael Ford to install a 74.3 square foot, internally illuminated wall-mounted sign for Garton Tractor. The property is located at 4088 Russell Road, in the Agricultural Suisun Valley 20-acre minimum (ASV-20) zoning district, APN: 0027-510-350. The project has been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). (Project Planner: Abigail Pipkin)
