FINDING A LANDSCAPE PROFESSIONAL

A landscape professional is not required for alternative compliance submission - however, projects may benefit from using a local contractor, irrigation designer, or landscape architect. Use the information below to find a qualified professional:

IRRIGATION - DESIGNERS

Can prepare an irrigation design plan and/or water use worksheet

LANDSCAPE - ARCHITECTS

Can prepare the landscape design plan, irrigation design plan, and/or water use worksheet

LANDSCAPE — CONTRACTORS (C-27)

Can prepare the landscape design plan, irrigation design plan, and/or water use worksheet

IRRIGATION AUDITORS

Can prepare an irrigation audit report after project installation.

OVERVIEW

Beginning in 2025, Solano County will conduct a water efficiency review on all projects meeting thresholds below:

- Located in the unincorporated areas of Solano County.
- New landscaping area is at least 500 square feet.
- Renovated landscaping is at least 2500 square feet.

Some exemptions apply (historical or mined-land reclamation projects with no irrigation,

- and botanical gardens/arboretums open to the public).
- Overall project is subject to a design review by Solano County. Typically, landscape projects would be flagged during a building application review.



Applicants will be required to submit either the package (projects between 500 and 2500 square feet). Completed landscape packages can be submitted via email to WELO@solanocounty.com, via the online submittal portal, via mail, or in our office with an appointment.

PLAN **APPROVAL**

The initial application package must include these two elements:



Project Worksheet. This page lists basic (f) information about the landscape project and contact information.




Landscape Design Plan. Comprehensive layout for the landscape project, complete with water features, mulching areas, plant and turf areas, and irrigation system.

Once project is completed, a second round of document submission is required. These two elements must be completed:

Certificate of Completion. The contractor (or architect) and the property owner must sign the completion certificate, certifying that the project was installed as per the approved plans.
