- a. CCP (Community Corrections Partnership) – Behavior Health Admin
 - AB 109 Budget has been approved for the next fiscal year.
 - Data handouts will be forwarded to this board.
 - No major changes to the system currently.
- b. Substance Use Disorder Administrator's Report –Behavior Health Admin
 - Aldea youth services are almost finalized and ready to implement.
 - Will serve the entire county
 - Offices in Fairfield and Vacaville
 - Services will be provided where it suits the client
- c. Substance Use Disorder Prevention Report – David Gao Chan
 - Public Health is issuing an RFQ for the final year of the strategic prevention plan

- The county issues between \$65,000-\$75,00 in grant funds
- There will be a new application style beginning in 2024
- Contract with DSS is in full swing.
 - Working on Opioid overdose Prevention and Opioid Initiation campaign that should roll out by next month.
 - Overdose campaign is made up of 4 people who are currently using legal drugs to help educate individuals on overdose possibilities.
- d. Opioid Safety Coalition (Drug Safe Solano)- Christina Kinnevey
 - Attending Substance Use Peer Navigators meetings to help with developing processes.
 - Establishing referral processes for clients being released from the jail.
 - Working on increasing data reporting for overdose reporting but wanting to pull local dates
 - Applied on several grants waiting for updates

VI. Public Comment

- a. The comment was made that we need to discuss what is going on in the ED's.
 - Patients should not be discharged to the streets.
- b. ED Director assured the board that they do not discharge patients to the streets that are not safe to do so.
 - All efforts are made to link patients to services before discharge
 - ED's can not force treatment to patients that do not want it

VII. Old Business

- a. Detox Plan- Presentation by Wendy with Partnership Healthplan
 - 3.2 level of care-social model detox.
 - This detox model is connected to residential programs.
 - There is currently 1 social model detox standalone facility and 1 social model detox connected to a residential program within Solano County.
 - Medical detox is covered by Drug Medical
 - Medical detox is 3.7 and 4.0 levels of care. These facilities are found in SoCal.
 - An incidental medical certificate is needed for this level of care.
 - Partnership provides transportation to treatment facilities for all MediCal covered individuals.
- b. Step down treatment facilities are also a challenge for providers.
 - Lack of facilities is a huge challenge
 - Solano County's Prop 47 funds housed a total of 101 individuals between 04/2021 and 03/2022
 - This had a huge impact of criminal recidivism and individual's wellbeing after treatment.
 - The ask is- Can Partnership show data on what the numbers are for alcohol withdrawl for detox in the ED's.
 - The recommendation was made for treatment providers to contact SUNS before sending patients to the ED's for detox.
