Certified law students and graduates will be able to argue motions in court, conduct evidentiary hearings and may be assigned to represent clients charged with misdemeanors, depending on experience.

We accept interns during the fall and spring semesters and summer. These positions are unpaid, but we will provide any assistance necessary if you are able to obtain course credit or grants.
