Upgrade to an energy-efficient home that is more durable and contributes to your health and safety through improved indoor air quality. You'll reduce energy use, increase comfort, and add value to your home—plus get cash incentives from the Bay Area Regional Energy Network!

Home Upgrade combines multiple improvements to increase your home's overall energy efficiency, saving you energy and money. Eligible home improvements include:

- Air sealing
- Duct sealing
- Insulation
- High-efficiency furnaces
- High-efficiency air conditioners
- High-efficiency water heaters



More Upgrades Mean Higher Incentives

All base and flex upgrade measures are worth a pre-determined number of points that count toward your Home Upgrade incentive. You must choose at least one base upgrade measure and a minimum of three total upgrade measures (base or flex). The more points you earn by combining upgrades, the higher the incentives you can receive.

Incentives are awarded at \$10 per point up to a maximum of \$3,000. An additional \$150 incentive is available to offset combustion safety testing costs of completed projects. There is a minimum of 100 points for a \$1,000 rebate.

Are You Eligible?

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) customers* who own a single-family home (1 to 4 units) are eligible for Home Upgrade incentives.

Points to Incentives
1 Point = \$10 in incentives
